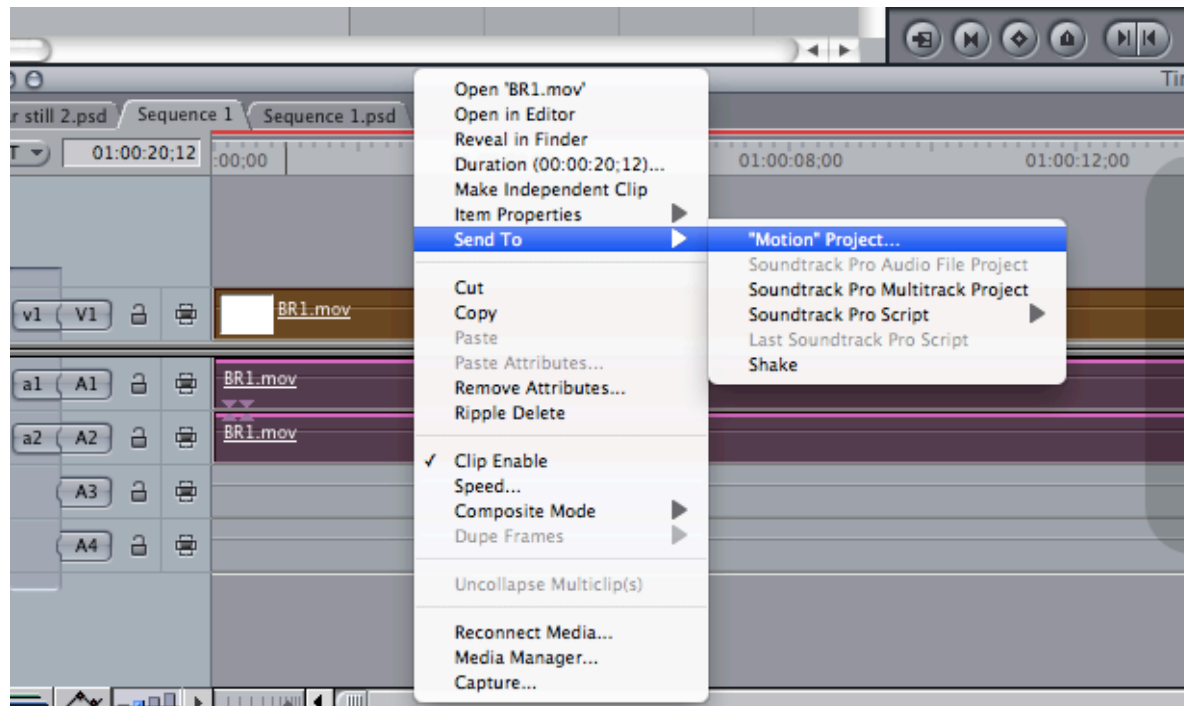


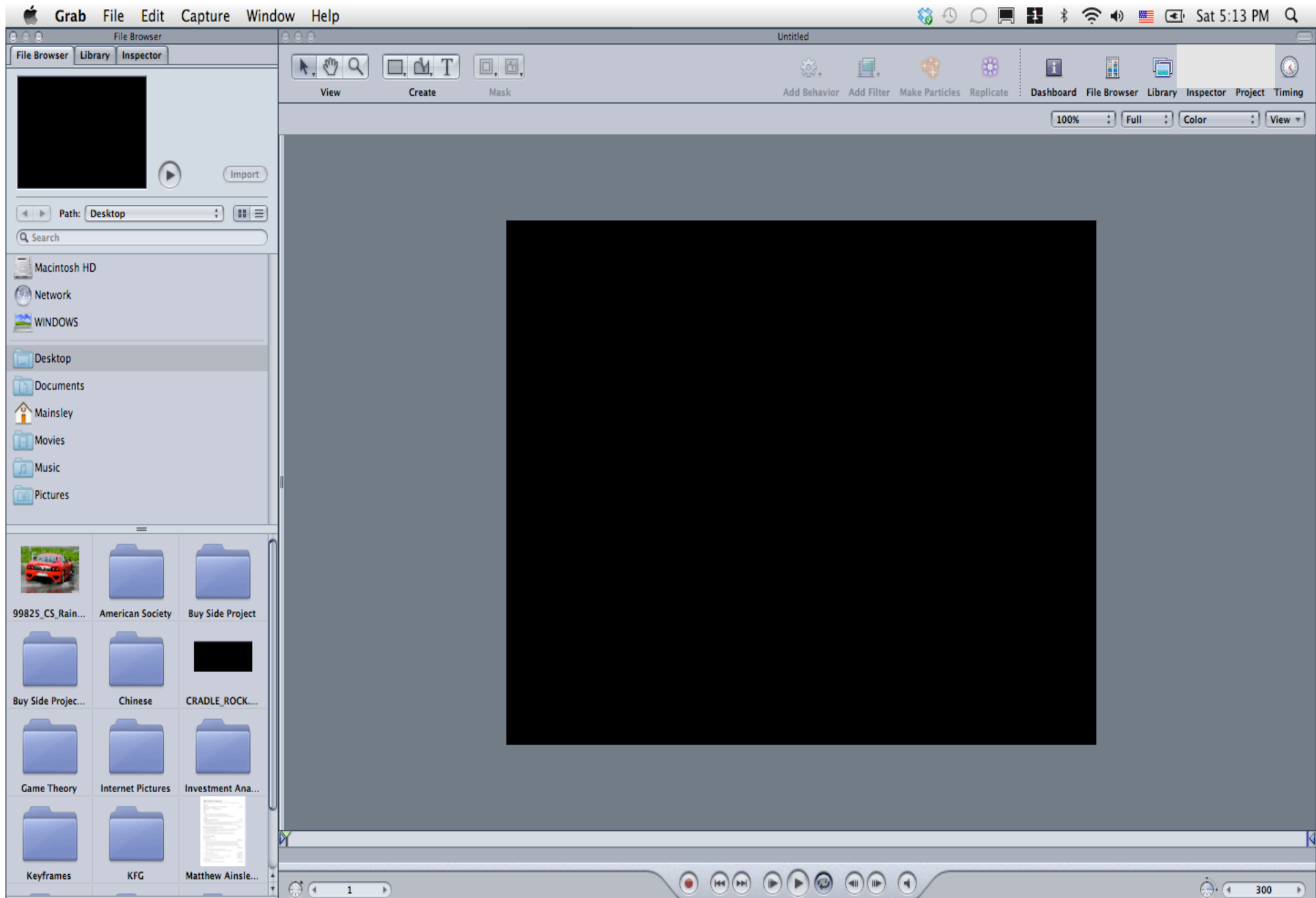

+ FCP -> Motion

- Taking footage from FCP and using it in Motion
 - Right Click -> Send to -> “Motion Project”

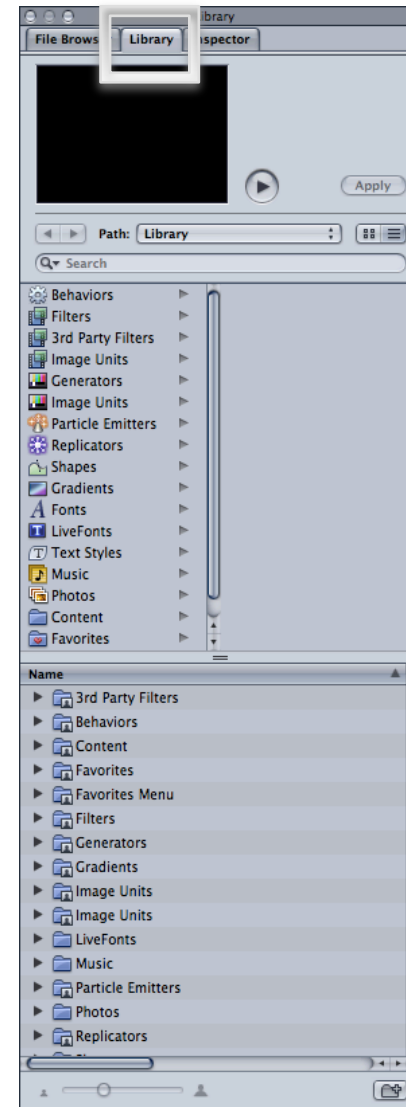




+ The interface

■ Library Tab

- This is where all of the effects and filters are going to be found
- It's as easy as dragging and dropping the icon onto the viewer window to apply the effects



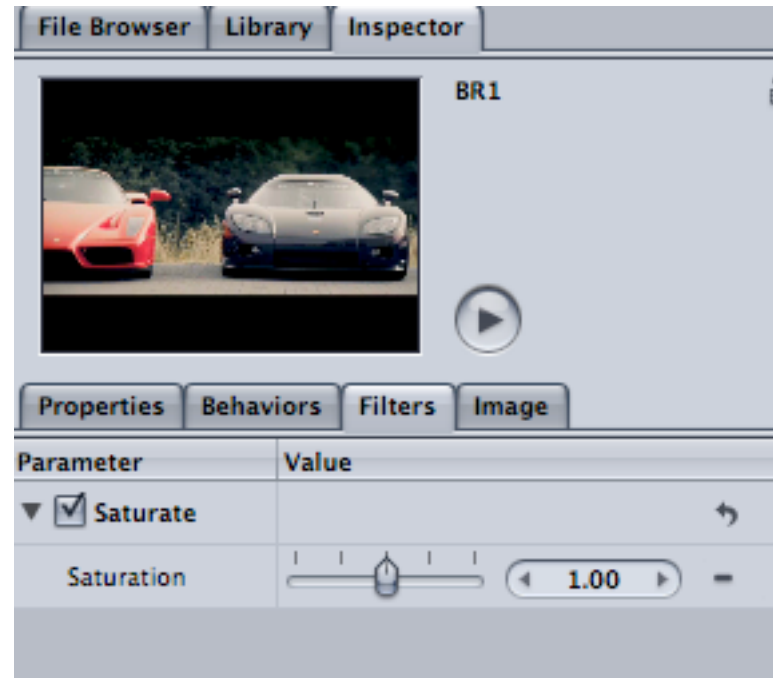
+ The interface



- This is the “viewer window”, which is where all of the effects can be applied and previewed.

+ Applying & Adjusting Filters

- To apply the filter, simply drag its icon onto the video
- To adjust the settings, go to the “inspector tab”
 - From here you can change the parameters to exactly what you want the clip to look like.



+ Going back to FCP

- A saved changed in Motion automatically gets updated in Final Cut Pro
- Also, you can open the saved motion file in Final Cut Pro
